7. How is the Lamb described? How can He be both the Lion and the Lamb?

What does this imply for us concerning the results of Christ's earthly sacrifice?

8. What is it that prompts 3 new songs?

9. Compare and contrast those songs recorded for us at the bottom of page 464 and the top of page 465?

How many ultimately join in the singing?

10. How would the fact that there is "a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it" have challenged and encouraged John and the persecuted Christians of the first century?

How should that same fact encourage and challenge us?
