5. What do you think it will be like to live without the presence of "death or mourning or crying or pain"?
6. Why do you think the one "seated on the throne" reintroduces Himself as "the Alpha and the Omega"? What are the implications and applications for us today of that name?

7. What are the implications and applications for us today of our Lord's invitation... "To the thirsty I will give WITHOUT COST from the spring of the water of life"?

8. How does the description of those who will be barred from the New Jerusalem compare with the 10 commandments?

9. John provides us with a description of the new Jerusalem from bottom of page 467 to the top of page 469. Many believe his description is a symbolic not a literal picture of that city. What do you think?

What might be implied by the dimensions of the city... "as wide and high as it is long"?

10. What do you think is the significance of the names written upon the gates and the foundations of the city?

11. What was the function of the temple in the Old Testament?

Why is there no need for a temple in the new Jerusalem?

12. What is implied about what life will be like for us in that city by the words "his servants will serve Him" and "they will reign forever and ever"?

13. Mediate upon this promise.... "they will see His face and His name will be on their foreheads."
