- 6. What is implied by Jesus' word of promise..."My reward is with me.."? Check out Matthew 25:14-23 and II Corinthians 5:10
- 7. Compare and contrast from the bottom half of page 469 those who will have access to the City and those who will not with the paragraph on the bottom of page 467.
